"Welcome to Year Four!"

Welcome back! We hope you had an enjoyable summer and we welcome your child to Year Four. We hope you find the following information useful.

- 😊 Year 4 children should enter and exit the school site via the side gate and enter the KS2 building from 08:30 using the side entrance in the mornings.
- 😊 The aim of Year 4 is to increase the children's confidence and independence as they develop through KS2.
- 😊 We encourage you to read with your child every night, then record it in their reading diary for them to bring in to school each day. You should read with your child a minimum of 3 times per week.
- 😊 We encourage you practise times tables with your child as this will be beneficial in all areas of mathematics and aim to develop their confidence for the National Multiplication Check in the summer term. Your support at home will have a huge impact on this.
- 😊 Homework for the week is written at the front of their homework books. Spellings are set on a Friday, to prepare children for their test the following Friday. English and Maths homework are also issued on Friday to be handed in Wednesday. Maths homework will now be online via MyMaths (logins will be provided).
- 😊 All homework is designed to support the children's learning in school and we expect it to be completed and handed in on time so that it can be marked and the children provided with feedback where necessary.
- 😊 Please ensure that your child comes into school wearing the appropriate kit on each classes P.E days P.E kits and School uniforms should be clearly labelled with your child's full name.
- 😊 Aspen Class has PE on a Wednesday and on a Friday.
- 😊 Willow Class has PE on a Monday and on a Thursday.
- 😊 If you need to speak with your child's class teacher please contact the school office to arrange a mutually convenient time. The start of the school day is extremely busy and the children have set routines, so please refrain from coming to the classrooms in the morning unless it is absolutely essential to see us first thing.
