"Welcome to Year Six!"

Welcome back! We would like to offer you all a warm welcome to Year 6. With it being your child's last year as a Junior, it promises to be a year to remember! We hope you find the following information useful.

- 😊 Year 6 children should enter and exit the school site via the side gate and walk straight to their classroom from 8:30am.
- 😊 The aim of Year 6 is to begin to increase the children's confidence and independence as they make the transition from Primary to Secondary Education along with preparation and success in their SATs exams.
- 😊 If you need to speak with your child's class teacher, please contact the school office to arrange a mutually convenient time. The start of the school day is extremely busy and the children have set routines, so please refrain from coming to the classrooms in the morning.
- 😊 We encourage you to read with your child every night then record in their reading diary and bring in to school each day along with practising times tables with your child which will be beneficial when answering arithmetic questions.
- 😊 Homework for the week is written at the front of their homework books. Spellings are set on a Monday to prepare children for their test on Friday of the same week. English and Maths homework are issued on Friday to be handed in Wednesday. Maths homework will continue to be online on MyMaths.
- 😊 All homework aids and supports the children's learning in school and we expect it to be completed and handed in on time so that it can be marked and the children provided with feedback where necessary.
- 😊 Please ensure that your child has the appropriate kit for P.E. with School uniforms and P.E kits being clearly labelled.
- 😊 PE for Year 6 is on Mondays. Both classes will complete their two hours of PE on this day.
- 😊 Year 6 have several trips and visits planned throughout the year such as: The Duxford Museum, The Natural History Museum and our Residential on the Isle of Wight in June for 4 nights, 5 days.
- 😊 Children will also be invited to an end of year celebration trip to Thorpe Park.
- 😊 There is further opportunity to be selected for our attendance trips where attendance is exceptional.
